In addition, the Board of Trustees is seeking Society approval to undertake the Cornerstone Campaign, a \$26,000,000 capital campaign. Total project costs will not exceed the campaign amount plus a 10% contingency. Construction may begin once 70% of the campaign goal has been secured through cash and/or confirmed pledges. In-person voting of The Cornerstone Campaign will take place at the meeting.
